5 vehicles can be parked in the driveway. RV/Trailer parking is allowed on-site.

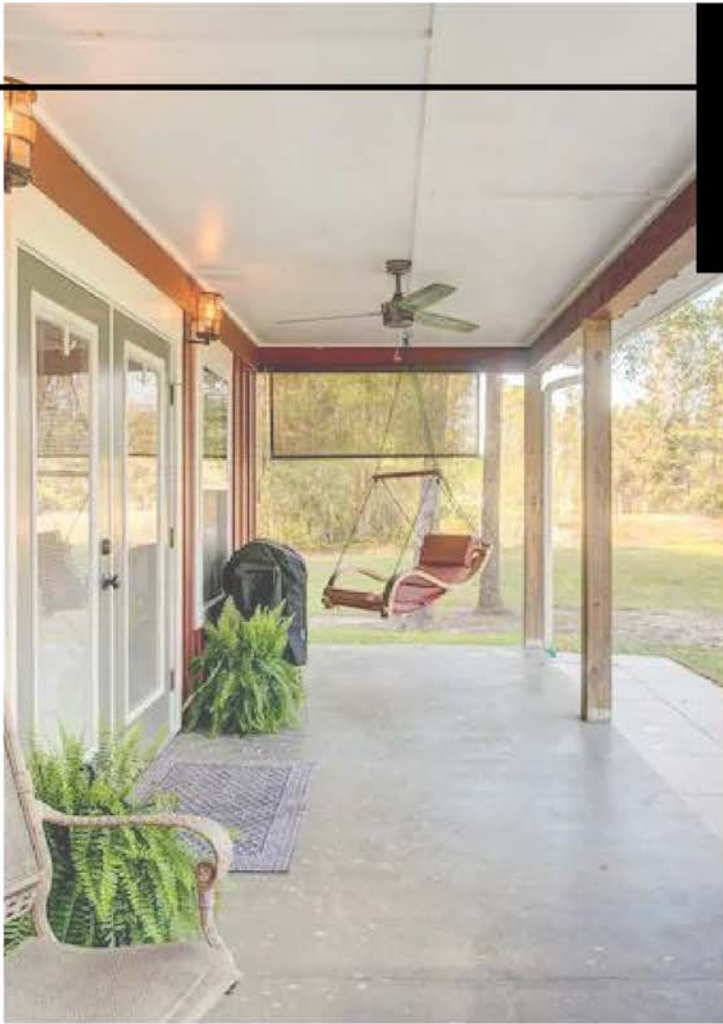


CHECK IN

GETTING COMFORTABLE

HOUSE GUIDE

Below are a few helpful tips and instructions on how to make your stay more comfortable and enjoyable!



WATER

Use gallon jugs (in the exposed pantry by the back door) for coffee. There's bottled water in the fridge for you to use and the faucet water is also safe for drinking.

Note: the ice maker does not work.



TV & NETFLIX

We have basic cable as well as Netflix. Push **both** remotes to turn everything on, then use the Dish remote to change the channels.



LAUNDRY

You are welcome to use the washer and dryer. Detergent is provided in the cabinet above the washing machine.



GRILL

There is a pellet grill on the porch that you may use. You can find extra pellets in the container by the grill.

FUN ON THE FARM

We want you to enjoy all the farm has to offer!

CHEROKEE LAKE

You are welcome to use: the beach to swim, docks & seating, the canoe & paddle boat, and the fishing boat with motor. Life jackets are also available at the boat house across the lake.

GOLF CART

Only adults or responsible youths with adult supervision can use it.

To start the cart: turn the key to on and depress the gas pedal. It may require you to pull the choke handle, below the driver's seat.

Please be careful as it is a working farm, especially along ditches and lake dam, etc. Enjoy driving around the farm on trails and around the lake, etc.

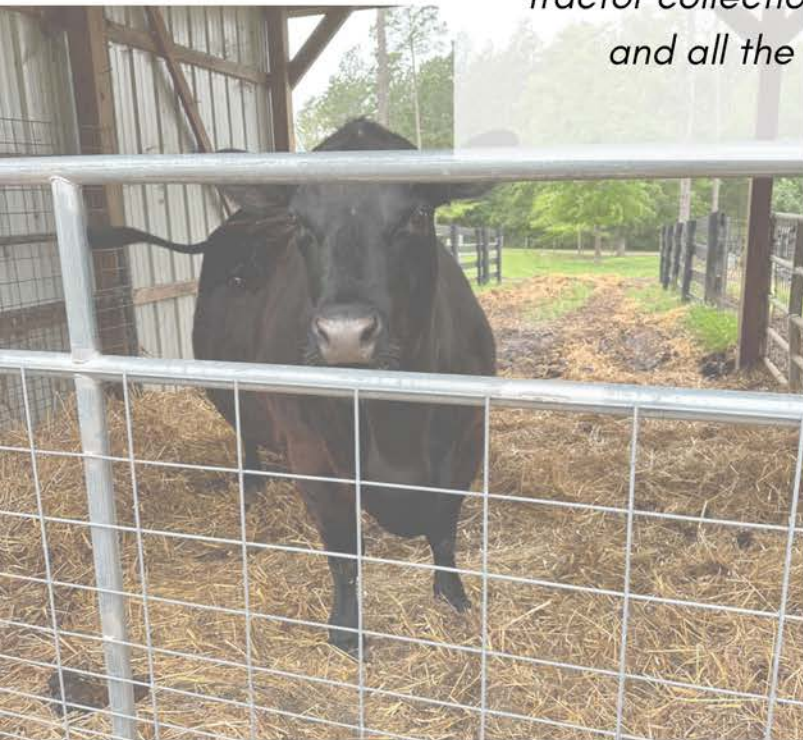
CAMP FIRE

Firewood and hot dog sticks are provided. Starter logs are located in the laundry room. We start fire with small sticks and pine cones (great fire starter), and then add logs to get the fire going. If you need assistance, just let us know. Please also be careful in windy conditions.



FARM TOURS

Enjoy your self-guided tour of the tractor collection, farm equipment, and all the farm animals!



The first four-legged friends you'll meet on the farm are most likely our farm dogs, Molly & Chase. We also have a lot of cows, a horse (Jason), a pony (Ruth), and several goats. We raise our own feed (corn, oats & hay) and grind feed for the cows in the feedlot. You can follow the paths around the fields and some along the waterways. We rotate between growing oats and corn in the fields.

Remember, this is a working farm so we and our workers are constantly doing things all over the farm. You are welcome to watch and enjoy as you so desire!

LINENS & TOWELS

Leave beds unmade and strip all linens from used beds. Please leave all used linens in a pile on the bed and place all used towels in the hamper located in the laundry room.



TRASH

Place all perishable items in the trash and kindly take trash bag to the outside bin, located near the parking spots. If pets are present, please clean up and dispose of their waste as well.



DISHES

Please load and start the dishwasher if you have any dirty dishes.
